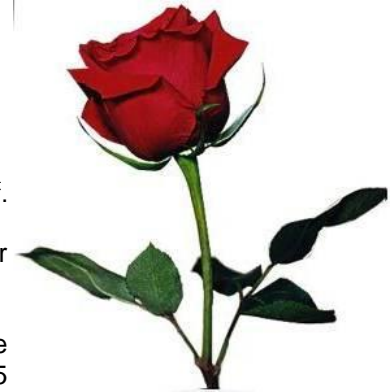
TCWC Cookbook
