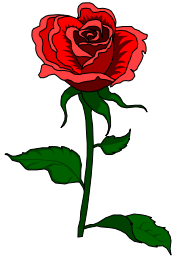



Growing up in Ft Worth she was active in drama and dancing. She attended the film Actors lab in Dallas where she did print work commercials, and corporate training videos and also worked as a paralegal in a law firm. Mary has maintained her paralegal business skills in her home business in TC.</p> <p>After moving to the Los Angeles area in the 1980s to pursue her acting career, she lived in Burbank because "it was more home-like". Her acting credits include being the "girl reporter" Kristie Koy on General Hospital for two years, (yes, she knew Luke and Laura), performing in episodes of Family Matters, and in Fresh Prince of Bel-Air and did commercials for companies like 7-11. Last year she appeared in Harold and Kumar Escape from Guantanamo Bay as Harold's mother.
