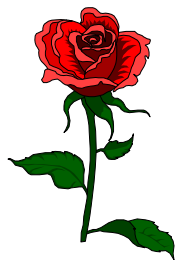

The book, compiled by her family, is a precious memory of her life in pictures. Mother of 5 very successful children, wife of her dear Chuck for over 61 years, businesswoman, volunteer, grandmother of 9 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren, bridge player, gardener, cook, caterer, reader, and now taking a computer class - the list of accomplishments and interests is long! She even tried motorcycle riding, cruising through Trophy Club with her brother and laments that no one saw her!</p> <p>Born in St Louis, MO, Lucile was active in vocal music and at age 5, received a beautiful, rare Italian accordion from her father. She later performed in an accordion band, and at restaurants and dinner theaters. Lucile and Chuck met at a skating rink – she "picked him up"! Together, they began one of the first Christian book stores in St. Louis. Subsequently, they lived in Rockford, IL. Tulsa, OK, Milwaukee, WI and then 28 years ago found Trophy Club and loved the terrain. They started a home business of promotional items which today is run by their son. Additionally, Lucile worked in Trophy Club as a manufacturer's rep and achieved Sales Rep of the year.</p> <p>Lucile was one of a group of women who founded the TCWC in the 80s, starting the gourmet groups and progressive dinner. Her love of people and zest for life is evident in her approach to life – now a widow, 81 years young, and a marvel to us all of a life well lived.</p>
