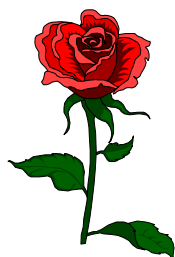



This Month we Meet: Smokey Duverne</p> 	<p>Smokey Duverne and husband Rene moved to Trophy Club in 1995, built their beautiful contemporary home and filled it with collectibles, an Amazon bird, Charlie, two rescue dogs and a built in tropical fish tank. Currently, there are also two rescued baby turtles in residence on the kitchen sink. Smokey is all of this and so much more. To meet with her and hear her life story is to open your eyes to adventure. Smokey had a “hippie” period for 7 months in the 70s when she and some friends traveled around in a van in southern Europe and North Africa. The appearance of camels drinking near their campsite one morning in Morocco is one of many delightful memories from this time.</p> <p>Smokey was raised in a military family, graduated from Stephen F Austin University and retired from her career as a flight attendant with American Airlines 7 years ago.
