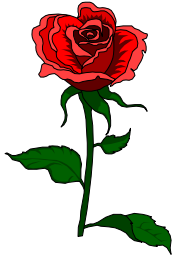

She first worked at age 15, cashiering and clerking at different businesses in town – one favorite job was at a bakery; oh, those chocolate chip cookies! She says she was a rebellious teen. After graduation she decided she wanted to see Europe. After several years of working in cosmetic sales and as a bartender, she took a test for placement as a “ditty bop” which is a Morse code operator for the Air Force. The recruiter signed her up quickly as, to her surprise, her tests showed a high mechanical aptitude. Lynne went off to basic training (never away from home before or on a plane), and once at Lackland AFB in San Antonio was tricked into being the Latrine Queen. She soon found out what that means! That honor, the surprise of hearing the Training Instructor (T.I.) yelling at her training group and getting used to many new rules marked the start of her military career. While in technical training school she went sky diving since it was something she had always wanted to do. Her work as a diesel engine mechanic then took her to Germany where she was stationed at Ramstein AB, near Kaiserslautern. She soon met her future husband, Reiner, who was also stationed there. They were married in Denmark and had many adventures traveling throughout Europe.
