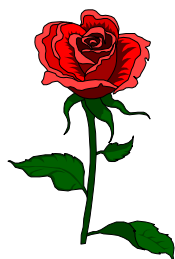

<p><b>Spotlight!</b> A Monthly Feature about our many talented, interesting members! <b>This Month we Meet:</b> <b>Sonja Tabor</b></p> 	<p>Sonja Tabor, a long time member of TCWC, has accumulated a lifetime of artistic accomplishments along with kudos from TCWC members for many enriching experiences! As the originator of Discovery Tours, she has guided ladies to interesting, exciting places for 13 years, and has many fond memories of these trips. She also, in 1981, was responsible for bringing artistic appreciation programs to children in Roanoke and Trophy Club Elementary schools, then training moms to present the successful program.</p> <p>Sonja grew up in Germany, living through four years of allied bombing, “spending most of that time in bomb shelters”. She moved to the US in 1952, locating in Houston where she received her training as a graphics illustrator. Sonja worked in this field for years while raising her two children. She continued to work in her beloved fields of realism and abstract painting, as well as sculpting, whenever time allowed. One notable piece of work was publicized widely when, in 2003, she created and donated a sculpture for the Komen Cancer Foundation.</p> <p>Sonja also lived in California where she loved her work as a museum docent. She recalled one time when other tours abandoned their leader and joined her group! Her home in Trophy Club is reflective of the richness of her taste, talent and interests. Talking with Sonja was a special treat.</p>
